I have been Gon to thee States & am on my way Back home i will leave for Forte Graham in thee morning i have Been Absent some 2 monthes i left orders At Home with Mr Lewis to make a land trade with you when i left home & i have not Been Able to Hare whether you have Been over or not or whether Any trade Has been made if none is made i wish for you to Come over imediately after you get this note for i will buy land As soon as i get Home i Have thee money to pay for a good track of Lande & Besides My buying there is Some 12 families from Ky now on there way to Forte Graham & they will All wonte to buy land neare me as they are all my acquaintances & they will wonte some 10 or 15 thousand Dollars of lany[?] & they Has their money to pay for it i am Dessposed to Buy from you if i Can be Suited & i have Controlle[?] All those others so i think you would find it to your interest to Come over forth with i will get home in 6 Dayes from this time & will wate a few days. this note i write hastely As i have but lelle time to write this note your Hastely &
