I drop you a few lines to inform you that I am in some little difficulty here at present Greenwade and myself had some words this evening and he shot at me twice I was unarmed I have shot him but am perfectly justifiable in doing so. tho I may be confined for a while if so I shall make J. J Scott your agent until it may be over. I would be glad you will come up if possible. You will hear from me again In great haste
