My Self & Family are all well noe dout by this you have lerned the death of our old frends Eubankes & Hilsman i war over at Grahan to day the plase looks very lonsum and in a bad fix Noe Postmaster and noe man in the plase that is qualified to attend to it Except the Eubanks Boyes noe publick house noe Store tho have got a little school my little gurle is going and teles me ther ar nine Scholers I lerne that tha or Several that wants to be agent of the plase I write in behalf of a Mr Isac whoe has his living on Doct Stiner farme for two yeares i lerne that he saes if he can get the agence he will move over ther and ceep intertament and also take the postoffice I will Sae that he is a clever Gentleman and a ver Respacable man and corect in all his dealings He is of a good family a neffew of Judg Isac of Tennessee Franklin County
