 the front landes - my object would be
 to live in the village & have land
 move ^{plants} to work it so i would not
 have to build - if this will not quite
 i would buy one third or half of
 the lease the village is on - i
 would like to have 1-2 & 3 years paymen
 my first i would pay the first of Decem-
 ber & so on i have a large family & could
 not be able to move sooner - i would
 of course to of send you had i of now
