Dear sir

I drop you a few lines in order to make some inquiries of you in relation to this tract of land on which I live I wish to know whether you have executed a bonafide title to this land to the Messrs Foster Fogg Dickinson and Co per John A Green of Austin their attorney which I would consider the proper grounds for them to make the demand of me for the possession as a decree of a Court having the proper jurisdiction I have not been informed of the fact in either case and should it be so in either case will you please drop me a line to that effect. I am informed by Judge Eubank as agent for John A Green that he is requested to take possession of the premises on which I live and act for him with a hope that I would not put him to trouble about possession I know or think so that I cannot be sustained in the possession without alliance with title and if title is transferred from you (as it has been my understanding your title was decreed to you by the supreme court) to Green's clients it only remains for me to yield the possession when I am credibly informed of the fact, for I am opposed to going to Law without good grounds and in this case it would not be for myself nor do I know whether Green will institute suit ^{against} me as your tenant but should it be the case

I think you should inform me the course you wish
me to take in the premises I have not forgot the prom-
ise I made should I leave the premises to let you
know beforehand I think it very likely I will
have sometime this year unless I can contract
for a home on the premises I cannot live this
way I must have some better house let me hear
from you as soon as convenient remaining
